SESSIONS 1 & 2: ELKHART MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL

REGISTRATION: Registration for all classes may be made at the school the student attends through **April 28, 2009**.

The enrollment minimum for all courses is 15. If minimum enrollment is not met, parents will be notified in time to select another class.

FEES: The registration fee is \$75 per semester unless indicated otherwise. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch pay a fee of \$15, exceptions noted.

TRANSPORTATION: Drop-off and pick-up times will be distributed in the schools during the last week of school. Transportation will be provided on a limited site pick-up basis. Transportation will be provided on a door-to-door pick-up basis for severely handicapped students.

Please note: Transportation routes will be determined based upon the April 28th registration deadline enrollment figures.

SELECTED COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Special Education – Intense Interventions

(MoMh, Severe Disabilities)

Course fee: \$75 (\$15 if the student qualifies for free or reduced lunch)

This course provides students with moderate and severe disabilities a variety of activities and experiences designed to reinforce their IEP goals. **Location:** Memorial

Classes will be held on Mon., Tues., Wed., and Thurs. for the weeks of June 8, 15, 22 and July 6 and 13.

Colorado Earth Science Field Experience

Offered to students entering Grades 9-12 next year. This course allows students to have academic experience in the classroom, followed and reinforced by a field excursion to the San Juan Mountains in Colorado. Locations: Three sessions of class at Memorial High School; 14 days of field experience (includes site work at Silverton, CO).

Marine Biology Field Experience

Offered to students entering Grades 10-12 next year. The marine biology class will be a learning situation of the ocean environment in Bar Harbor, Maine compared to lake, river, and pond environments in our local area. Students will collect organisms for dissections and collect abiotic data to compare freshwater living conditions to marine living conditions.

Learning will be conducted with field trips that include a class at High Dive Park, a tour of Mt. Desert Island Biological Laboratory, a whale watching tour, canoeing, snorkeling, kayaking, a visit to a lobster hatchery and Diver's Ed theater. From these experiences students will receive information about scientific methods, classification, evolution, genetics, ecology, math and technology.

U.S. History Field Experience

For students entering Grade 11 next year. This course gives students academic experience in the classroom, followed by a 14-day field experience where students will study the geographic, economic, and historic significance of locations between Elkhart and the Atlantic Coast, primarily the Boston-Plymouth, Washington, D.C.-Arlington, and the Gettysburg-Philadelphia areas.

Fee: \$850, minimum enrollment: 40

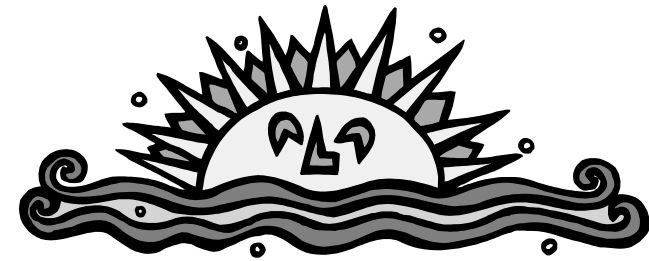
